- 3 CLUB UPDATES – It is the responsibility of your club to notify the SRC of any changes to their club/members in regards to vehicles on club rego. Please forward a list of owners details and vehicle details that are part of your club. This helps the SRC keep up to date records. Please forward these details ASAP.
- 4 Discussion on SR rego renewals – Should a club representative co-ordinate the club rego paperwork, and forward it to Emmanuel as a whole club. This will make sure that all club members return there Travel Authority Card.
- 5 Discussion on Travel Authority Cards – How can we police the renewal of the cards each year
- 6 Discussion on fenders – Fenders will stay for club rego requirements. The RTA's view is that it will stop pedestrians form walking into the wheel.
